- Served over 13,000 Mississippians, reaching every area of the state
- Developed the C.A.R.E. program in response to the COVID crisis - 15 care sites established, 150 students enrolled, as well as 300 educators and caregivers served

- Trained over 3,500 educators, social workers, and caregivers on child behavior
